Another one was **Joe Szczupakiewicz**`s 800 Freestyle, on Saturday night after 3 (tiring) sessions of competition, the last event of the night, he went a 10:13 in the 800 Free. Splitting it with a 5:04 on the first 400 and coming back in a 5:09 on the back 400. Good enough for the 2nd place state medal. Joe went to the podium, medaling in 5 of his 6 events. WOW!! Not to be over shadowed was **Ashland Schoofs** 100 BK she swam a 121.9in that event , taking the 3rd place championship medal.That is only 2 tenths of a second off of a AAAA time for a very young 9 year old....Thats amazing!..**Carolyn Jungers**, who has had a phenomenal season, topped it off by going 5 for 6 in personal best times and going to the podium to receive state championship medals in 5 out of 6 events. Her best was 3rd place finishes in both her 200 IM and 100 breast. And the best anchor leg of a relay went to **Adam Fleischhacker**,in the 11-12 boys 200 free relay. He started out in 6th position and ended up in 3rd and almost pushed them into 2nd. IT was amazing! All in all it was a great meet for our team , and I was proud to be their coach that weekend .
